1- Analysis of the plan and implementation rates in the past year :

Most of the paragraphs of the scientific plan have been completed, especially with regard to the scientific aspects. As for the administrative aspects, issues remain unfinished, due to several obstacles that we will address through paragraph No. 2 .

D -The lack of sufficient classrooms and the narrowness of the building space compared to the number of students accepted for the past year .

E -The small number of specialized teachers in our department, and a number of them devote themselves to postgraduate studies .

F -the delay in fulfilling many of the requirements of the scientific department by the Deanship.
