#### MAINTENANCE OF UNIVERSITY EQUIPMENT AND SITES

The University of Basrahh attracted an amateur group consisting of doctors at the College of Medicine Al-Zahra, engineers and employees interested in the manufacture of electronic models with automatic control, where they officially joined the university and formed a remote control team of the University of Basrahh. The team produced a controlled boat to collect water samples from the rivers for study and in record time and was tested in the Basrah River, where it collected (500) ml of water samples efficiently and very quickly. Al-Sada is now the first model of the boat ready for use by the university team to control the pollution of the Shatt Al-Arab water, and there are future projects that the team is currently working on, including the flying pharmacy and the controlled agricultural plane that sprays seeds to plant large areas of perennial trees, as well as a special plane to spray pesticides and finally boats to take mud samples from the bottom of the rivers.




