Prof. Dr. Alaa Karim Naima, a lecturer in the Department of Food Science, College of Agriculture, University of Basrah, in cooperation with a research team consisting of Eng. Walaa



Sabri Rahim, Prof. Ibrahim Abdullah Merdas and Prof. Dr. Hussein Aliwi from the University of Babylon, obtained a patent issued by the Ministry of Planning / Central Organization for Standardization and Quality Control to enable them to design and implement an electronic system for the detection of agricultural pesticide residues in raw milk.

Agricultural pesticide residues in raw milk. A set of wireless sensors such as a temperature sensor, an acid function sensor and a sensor for measuring dissolved solids in liquids were used, where these sensors were controlled using microcontrollers and artificial intelligence based on artificial neural networks and were trained to diagnose and distinguish between different types of pesticide residues with raw milk. It is one of the low-cost quick and easy ways, as the concentrations of pesticide residues, which are estimated at parts per million for both bishroudhrin and cypermethrin clyphosate, were detected, and they were identical to the quantities obtained when detecting by high-performance liquid chromatography and mass gas chromatograph.

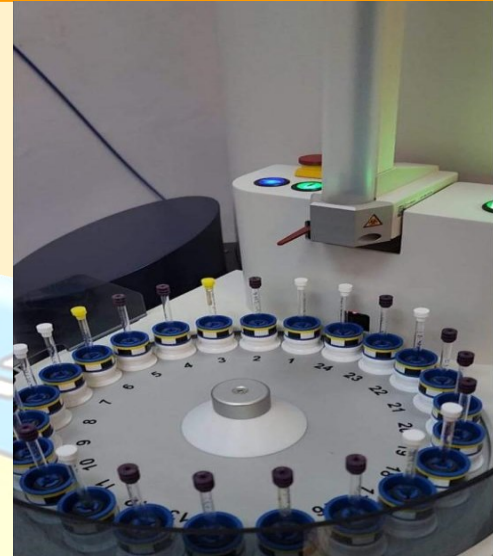

The official of the devices in the Department of Chemistry at the College of Education for Pure Sciences, Dr. Faiza Abdul Karim Nasser, indicated that this device is the first of its kind to enter service in Iraqi universities after Iraq was removed from the list of the seventh item. Nasser added that the university obtained this device from the local government in Basrah after submitting an official request to the governor to indicate the actual need in the university's laboratories for graduate students and researchers in scientific colleges. Dr. Faiza added that nuclear magnetic resonance spectroscopy is a method for determining the chemical structure of organic compounds, a research technique that uses the magnetic properties of some atomic nuclei and determines the physical and chemical properties of atoms or molecules that contain them, and it depends on the phenomenon of nuclear magnetic resonance and can give platologic information about the structure, dynamics, state of interaction and chemical environment of moleculesThe magnetic field inside the molecule around an atom in a molecule changes the resonance frequency and this gives information about the electronic structure of the molecule. The device is of Swiss-German origin for BRUKER and is considered a qualitative leap in the field of scientific research for its importance in diagnosing organic and biological synthetic compounds, as well as conducting special studies on vehicles.

The aim of the design of this radar is to extract high-precision information from the targets where the correct value of the gain of the ring (G) has been carefully set in the phase lock ring (PLL) in order to restore the signal more reliably. In this system, PLL synchronization and radar interconnection are enough to restore the echo

Synchronization of Monostatic Radar Using a Time-Delayed Chaos-Based FM Waveform

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Abstract: There is no doubt that chaotic systems are still attractive issues in various radar applications and communication systems. In this paper, we present a new 0.3 GHz mono-static microwave chaotic radar. It includes a chaotic system based on a time-delay to generate and process frequency modulated (FM) waveforms. Such a radar is designed to extract high-resolution information from the targets. To generate a continuous FM signal, the chaotic signal is first modulated using the voltage control oscillator (VCO). Next, the correct value for the loop gain (G) is carefully set when utilizing the Phase-Locked Loop (PLL) at the receiver, so that the instantaneous frequency that reflects a chaotic state variable can be reliably recovered. In this system, the PLL synchronization and radar correlation are enough to recover the echo signal and detect the target. The finding indicates that the system can be implemented with no need to use the complex self-synchronization or complex prospective synchronization schemes as compared to the existing chaotic radar systems. The simulation results show that the short-time cross-correlation of the transmitted and reconstructed waveforms is good and satisfactory to detect the target under various signal-to-noise ratio (SNR) levels and with less complexity in the design.

Keywords: synchronization; chaotic time-delay; Phase-Locked Loop (PLL); mono-static radar; Chaotic FM Radar

1. Introduction

After decades of research, the chaotic signal is experiencing rapid development in many fields, such as engineering and science. In a variety of applications, chaotic signals have been observed, including mechanics, electronics, chemistry, and acoustics. Since it owns many of the features that distinguish it, such as the chaotic signal random-in-time involvement with no periodicity, but rather the signal energy is distributed across all ranges of frequency and a chaotic signal can be generated from simple chaotic deterministic systems, the noise-like and complex behavior of a chaotic signal could have advantages in various fields of practical applications, such as being used in radar systems [1–3]. This feature of the chaotic signal makes the radar signal simple to implement, less sensitive to jamming or interference, and easy to process.

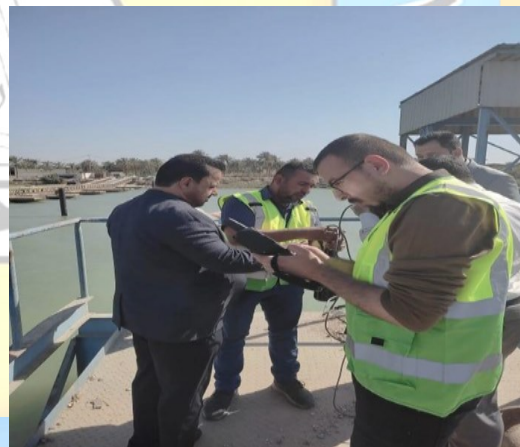
