The conference recommended the establishment of a database on water quality in the Iraqi marshes, the activation of environmental laws to maintain water quality, prevent the release of organic pollutants and sewage in the marshes, and the need to conclude legal agreements to provide sufficient water quotas to ensure the arrival of fresh water, avoid entering the salt front, change the environment, hold violators accountable for the safety of Shatt al-Arab water, and establish liquid and solid waste treatment plants.






research and drawing conclusions and the resulting patents or products that may be harnessed as medical products to serve the community.

Chronic tonsillitis They underwent tonsillectomy as a result of the recurrence of tonsillitis more than (four - seven) times a year and because of the frequency and increase of complications caused by this inflammation such as: high temperature, loss of appetite, difficulty eating and drinking. This leads to tonsillectomy, which is the appropriate treatment. Where these toxins were isolated and characterized based on international references and centers and using modern molecular techniques.







Dr. Osama Ayoub Yaqoub and Dr. Mohsen Saghir Ghaleb published a paper entitled (Synergistic Evaluation in the Antioxidant Effect of Taxifoline and Vitamin C Combination Therapy against Diazinon-Induced Renal Impairment) in the Egyptian journal Bulletin of Pharmaceutical Sciences Assiut University with an impact factor of 0.9 and within Scopus containers. The study aimed to evaluate the synergy in the antioxidant effect of taxifoline and vitamin C combination therapy against diazinon-induced renal impairment and the study showed that the administration of subacute taxifoline and vitamin C has a protective effect of the kidneys against oxidative stress induced by dizinone.


In vitro anticancer activity of RA extracts of peppermint leaves against human cancer breast and cervical cancer cells in the Japanese Teikyo Medical Journal, the research included studying the effectiveness of rosmarinic acid against breast cancer and human cervical cancer in the laboratory. Factors: Breast cancer (MCF-7 cervical cancer) cell line (HELA)) as well as studying the anti-cancer effects of rosmarinic phenolic acid extracted and purified from mint in the laboratory. Where rosmarinic acid was tested in the laboratory on N7 breast cancer cells at concentrations of 100,250,500,750,1000 µg / ml and human cervical cancer at concentrations of 100, 250, 500 and 1000 µg / ml where rosmarinic acid reduced the effectiveness and growth of breast cancer cells by 48% at a concentration of 1000 µg / ml while the effect of acid on the effectiveness of normal cells was only 4% at the same concentration, which gives rosmarinic acid a selective property of breast cancer cells. As for the cervical cancer cell line, the acid did not show Noticeable effect on the activity and growth of cancer cells.

Antioxidant Activity of Rosmarinic Acid Extracted and Purified from *Mentha piperita* in the Iranian Journal of Archives of Razi Institute. The research included studying the antioxidant effect of rosmarinic acid in the laboratory on three factors and showed laboratory results of antioxidant activity in the test of displacement of free radicals generated by DPPH Gu O antioxidant effect, which is close to the effect of standard vitamin C, where the inhibition rate was 95.58% at a concentration of 100 µg/ml of rosmarinic acid and 87.83% at a concentration of 100 µg/ml in a free radical displacement test using hydrogen peroxide. The

aim of the research was to evaluate the antioxidant activity of rosmarinic acid in the laboratory. The research included the study of antioxidant activity by 3 agents-diphenyl-1-picrylhydrazyl-1(DPPH). 2- hydrogen peroxide H₂O₂ (Ferric Reducing Anti-Oxidant Power Assay)REDOX– 3

Prevalence of Drug-Drug Interaction in Hospitalized Patient in Basrah City; Southern of Iraq

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Abstract

Objectives: Although multiple drugs administration most increase therapeutic effect, some combinations lead to adverse drug-drug interactions and increased morbidity. This study was designed to identify the types, frequency, severity, and significance of drug-drug interactions (DDIs).

Methods: This retrospective cross-sectional study was conducted from September 2018 to February 2019 in Al-Fayha's teaching hospital in Basrah, Iraq. The data of 186 patients were collected from hospital patients case sheets. The type and significance of DDIs were analyzed using "Medscape drug Interaction Checker".

Results: At least one to two DDI are noticed in about three quarters of the patients, about 30% cases have three to nine DDIs and 15% of them have ten or more DDIs. According to their severity, there are 85 (11.5%) of serious or potent DDIs. The largest percentage of reported interactions 544 (73.5%) were moderate were close monitoring required. Out of 746 documented DDIs, 63.1% were pharmacodynamics and 19.9% were Pharmacokinetic interactions, in addition, there were 15.4% of DDIs due to Unknown mechanisms. Most of the major potential DDIs occur with the antibiotic ceftriaxone and blood thinning medications (heparin and warfarin).

Conclusion: The findings of this study revealed a high prevalence of drug-drug interactions in hospitalized patients particularly in patients with cardiovascular disease. Potential DDIs in this study sufficiently high to alert health care providers to pay more attentions in order to prevent or decrease their adverse effects on patients.

Introduction

Drug-drug interactions (DDIs) widely occur in hospitalized patient especially in patients use long list of medications. A drug interaction occurs when the pharmacological effects of the one medication alters the intensity of the other concomitant drug. When two or more medications are taken together, there is a chance of an interaction among the drugs that could be manifested as an increase or decrease in the therapeutic effects or lead to serious unwanted effects which may change the clinical outcome of the patients.^[1] Polypharmacy and increased age are significant risk factor for these interactions.^[2-3] DDIs generally classified as pharmacodynamic and pharmacokinetic interactions that sub-classified according to mechanism of interactions into absorption, distribution, metabolism and elimination.^[4] Potential DDIs are one of the preventable mechanisms of adverse drug events and health damage.^[5] Frequency of potential DDIs markedly increase in prescriptions for hospitalized patients.^[6] The clinical outcome of a possible DDIs is usually unknown.^[7] Studies show that the patients may expose to one or more major or moderate DDIs during hospitalization especially in internal medicine wards and the probability these interactions increased when use more than 6 drug items.^[8-10] Although DDIs are common in the hospitalized patients, but there are few data reporting these interactions clinically. It is difficult to remember all the known important DDIs.

Academic Staff at the College of Pharmacy at the University of Basrah Zainab Najm Abdul Nabi, teacher Noor Kazem Jawad and Assistant Professor Dr. Jubran Khalil Hassan published a research entitled (The occurrence of drug interactions in patients hospitalized in Basrah, southern Iraq) in the Indian Journal of Forensic Medicine and Toxicology in India with an impact factor of 0.25. The research included follow-up of the type and importance of drug interactions of drugs taken by patients admitted to Al-Fayhaa Hospital in Basrah because of their impact on the patient's health and recovery. Knowing the harmful drug interactions that lead to an increase in the deterioration of the disease, as the type of frequency and severity of drug interactions were diagnosed to know the drugs that may not be given together in the disease because they may lead to

significant health damage


