

# The Academic Program Description



#### Introduction:

The educational program is a coordinated and organized package of academic courses that include procedures and experiences organized in the form of academic vocabulary, the main purpose of which is to build and refine the skills of graduates, making them qualified to meet the requirements of the labor market. It is reviewed and evaluated annually through internal or external audit procedures and programs such as the external examiner program. This guide, in its second edition, includes a description of the academic program after updating the vocabulary and paragraphs of the previous guide in light of the latest developments in the Educating al system in Iraq, which included a description of the program in its traditional form (annual, quarterly), in addition to adopting the description of the academic program that circulated due to the letter of the Department of Studies, T M 3/2906 on 5/3/2023, for the programs that adopt the Bologna Process as a basis for their work.

In this area, we can only emphasize the importance of writing descriptions of academic programs and courses to ensure the smooth conduct of the Educating al process.

# The Description of the Academic Program:

The academic program description provides a summary of its vision, mission, and objectives, including an accurate description of the targeted learning outcomes according to specific learning strategies.

## **Course Description:**

It provides a necessary summary of the most important characteristics of the course and the learning outcomes that the student is expected to achieve, demonstrating whether he has made the most of the available learning opportunities. It is derived from the program description.

## **Program Vision:**

An ambitious picture for the future of the academic program is to be an advanced, inspiring, motivating, realistic, and applicable program.

#### **Program Mission:**

It briefly explains the objectives and activities necessary to achieve them and also identifies the program's development paths and directions.

## **Program Goals:**

They are statements that describe what the academic program intends to achieve within a specific period and are measurable and observable.

## **Curriculum Structure:**

All courses/study subjects included in the academic program according to the approved learning system (semester, annual, Bologna track), whether it is a requirement (ministry, university, college, or scientific department), along with the number of study units.

#### **Learning Outcomes:**

A compatible set of knowledge, skills, and values that the student has acquired after completing the academic program. The learning outcomes for each course must be determined in a way that achieves the program objectives.

#### The Strategies of Teaching and Learning:

They are the strategies used by the faculty member to develop the student's teaching and learning, and they are plans that are followed to reach the learning goals. That is, it describes all curricular and extracurricular activities to achieve the learning outcomes of the program.


