Concepts and terminology:

Description of the academic program: The description of the academic program provides a brief summary of its vision, mission, and goals, including an accurate description of the targeted learning outcomes according to specific learning strategies. Course Description: Provides a necessary summary of the most important characteristics of the course and the learning outcomes that the student is expected to achieve, demonstrating whether he or she has made the most of the available learning opportunities. It is derived from the program description.

Program Vision: An ambitious picture for the future of the academic program to be a developed, inspiring, motivating, realistic and applicable programme.

The program's mission: It briefly explains the goals and activities necessary to achieve them, and also defines the program's development paths and directions.

Program objectives: These are statements that describe what the academic program intends to achieve within a specific period of time and are measurable and observable.

Curriculum structure: All courses/study subjects included in the academic program according to

the approved learning system (semester, annual, Bologna track), whether it is a requirement

(ministry, university, college, or scientific department), along with the number of study units.

Learning outcomes: A consistent set of knowledge, skills, and values that the student has acquired

after the successful completion of the academic program. The learning outcomes for each course

must be determined in a way that achieves the program objectives. Teaching and learning

strategies: They are the strategies used by the faculty member to develop the student's teaching

and learning, and they are plans that are followed to reach the learning goals. That is, it describes

all curricular and extracurricular activities to achieve the learning outcomes of the programme.
